- The track "Blind To The Facts" has reached over 11,000 downloads since it was released.
- Performed over 200 concerts throughout the years along with Timbuktu all over Scandinavia.
- Featured on and produced the hit single "U Call That Love?" with J-Ro (Tha Alkaholiks), a huge success in France.
- Chords has performed for sold out crowds in such venues as Joe's Pub (NYC), The Roxy (L.A.) and Elysées Montmartre (Paris).
- The debut album "The Garden Around The Mansion" was released in Scandinavia, Germany, Australia and the U.S.
- Chords side-project, the reggaeband Helt Off have received much success with their two albums in Sweden.
- Among the artists Chords has worked and toured with include Timbuktu, Looptroop Rockers, Tingsek and Masta Ace.

American / Swedish artist Chords grew up in Lund (Sweden) and Baltimore (U.S.) and gained an interest for music at an early age. Chords quickly started making demos and performing shows in his hometown of Lund. His music travelled over to various hip-hop mixtapes, compilations and vinyl singles along with his group at the time.

One of Sweden's biggest artists today, Timbuktu, brought Chords along in early 2002 as his side-kick on tour. They've done over 300 shows together during the years, all over Scandinavia and Germany as well as shows in NYC and Los Angeles. Chords recorded his debut album in 2002 while on tour, later released in 2003. The album gained the respect of Scandinavian press and radio, and toured with fellow group Looptroop Rockers in Europe. In 2004 and 2006, Chords released two albums with his side-project, Swedish reggae group Helt Off. Also in 2006, Chords debut album, "The Garden Around The Mansion" saw it's U.S. release, he also did the single of the clothing company WESC's compilation album "Get Physical" along with Timbuktu, as well as having 5 tracks in the Dolph Lundgren action film "Direct Action".

Prior to the new album, "Things We Do For Things", Chords recorded and produced with legendary hip-hop artist J-Ro from Tha Alkaholiks, and their single "U Call That Love?" was in high rotation in France, making it the most requested song on Generation FM in 2007. The new Chords album is now released in Scandinavia, receiving outstanding reviews from the press and media. The art work for the album is also special in the way that each track on the album has it's own movie poster, making each song a single in it's own right.

Two videos from the album are now up and playing, the first single "Luckiest Man Alive" as well as video for the track "Appetite For Consumption" taped in Venice Beach. Currently Chords is on tour in Scandinavia, which is a solid performance of the new album live.

Chords is an incredible artist, his versatility shows just that, just listen to his album and you'll understand what he's about.
